Station Rd	<b>19</b>	<b>18</b>	<b>18</b>	<b>12</b>	Total: 65 marks. Litter control quite good. No major improvements evident since last judging.
Circular Rd	<b>20</b>	<b>19</b>	<b>18</b>	<b>13</b>	Total: 70 marks A nice residential road with a lot of potential to improve. Litter well controlled. Grass and weeds along footpaths/kerbs still evident and havent been tackled at all.
Ballina Rd	<b>20</b>	<b>17</b>	<b>17</b>	<b>17</b>	Total: 71 marks. Again a nice residential area. The last few houses at Railway Terrace need painting but overall a lot has been achieved here since first judging. Grass/weeds/moss along footpaths are still a major problem and this doesnt appear to have been addressed at all and looks unsightly – if every resident tackled the area outside their own premises a lot could be achieved. Also some painting of front boundary walls would also be an enhancement.

Main Street	19	19	18	18	Total: 74 marks. Unfortunately this street started out with great enthusiasm but the standard has dropped. Weeds evident along footpaths, also sweepings. Some litter evident on judging day also. The benches havent been painted as suggested in earlier remarks. The hanging baskets are also looking very unkept. It would seem that the initial momentum has lapsed somewhat. Everyone needs to get involved to maintain this street as it is the busiest street in the town and much trafficked.
Market St	<b>18</b>	<b>19</b>	<b>19</b>	<b>13</b>	Total: 69 marks Litter was fairly well controlled. Hanging baskets have been removed at top of street. No improvements evident since last judging. There is potential for improvement here in next year's judging.
Bridge St	19	18	16	10	Total: 63 marks. No improvement evident here since last judging. More effort needs to be put in here by all business premieses/residents to make an impression in next years judging. It is only a short street after all and much can be achieved.

Dublin Rd	<b>19</b>	<b>19</b>	<b>18</b>	<b>15</b>	Total: 71 marks. A little litter evident. Grass verges well maintained but starting to get overgrown especially opposite Corrib Oil as you approach the N.5 junction. The painting of the boundary wall of the VEC building has made a great improvement. Some other boundary walls could do with painting.
Brookville Ave	19	12	7	7	Total: 45 marks A lot of work needed here to get into the running in next years judging. The backways to the businesses on Main St. are a major problem here.
Davitt Place	20	20	20	18	Total: 78 marks This street has been consistently good at each judging. It is evidently well maintained with little evidence of littering and always looks tidy. Well done to all here and keep up the good work!!

Riverside	20	15	16	13	Total: 64 marks Grass and weeds still evident. The only improvement evident here is the painting of the wall into Sancta Maria which has brightened up this area. A lot of work to be done here to get into the running next year.
Kiltimagh Rd	20	18	20	12	Total: 70 marks Litter well controlled. Grass verges well maintained but grass/weeds still evident along footpaths/walls which havent been addressed.
Chapel St	20	20	20	15	Total: 75 marks A whole lot achieved here since last judging and what a transformation it has made. What a difference a little paint can make to a derelict building – other streets take note!..but please take the growth out of the roof. Love the murals on the wall at Doctors surgery – what a difference. Also the ESB building is looking much brighter. This street has taken on nearly all points highlighted in our first judging. It is just such a shame that the burst came so late in the judging as it could well be in the running for street winner. A whole lot achieved though – so keep up the good work.

Park Rd	19	20	19	17	Total: 75 marks. A lovely residential road with some lovely gardens. Grass verges well maintained. Grounds of Aras Attracts very impressive. Grass/weeds evident along footpaths.
Kilkelly Rd	20	17	17	16	Total: 70 marks. Litter well controlled. Grass verges mostly well maintained but a few areas need attention. Overall a lot was achieved here since first judging so keep up the good work here for next year.
Pound Lane	18	18	12	10	Total: 58 marks No major improvement here. The street surface is rough – grass and weeds still evident. Needs brightening up with a good bit of effort needed.

St. Itas Tce	18	18	15	13	Total: 63 marks No evidence of any improvement here since the first judging. A kickstart is definitely needed next year to get into the race.
